Call for Abstracts

The EAACI Congress 2017 Scientific Programme Committee and the Local Organising Committee welcome the submission of original contributions for oral and poster presentations.

Abstract Submission

Abstract submission will open on 20 October 2016. The deadline to submit abstracts is 15 January 2017. Notifications of acceptance or rejection of abstracts will be sent to the corresponding author of the abstract by the beginning of March 2017. - It is the presenting author's responsibility to submit a correct abstract.
- Presented abstracts will be published in <u>Allergy</u> after the Congress

Congress Scholarship

The EAACI Congress 2017 and the Local Organising Committee offer 100 Congress Scholarships to EAACI Junior Members. A scholarship application can only be made in connection with an abstract submission and must be applied for by the presenting author of an abstract. The application deadline is 15 January 2017. As a Congress Scholarship recipient you will receive complimentary registration to the Congress, as well as shared accommodation in a twin-bedded room (up to four nights) and have travel costs refunded up to EUR 500.

EAACI Abstract Award

All abstract presenters automatically enter the competition for the EAACI abstract award of EUR 200. The award winners will be announced at the EAACI booth during the Congress and on the website.

Registration

The presenting author of an abstract must register for the Congress by 31 March 2017. Until this date the presenting author is offered a prolonged "early fee". All presenting authors must be registered before this date in order to publish their abstract in the Congress programme, on the Congress website and in the app. The registration fee may be refunded if the abstract is rejected.

Presentations

Accepted abstracts will be presented in Oral Abstract Sessions, Poster Discussion Sessions and Thematic Poster Sessions.

About Helsinki

Helsinki is the capital and largest city of Finland. It is located in the region of Uusimaa, in southern Finland, on the shore of the Gulf of Finland. The Helsinki metropolitan area is the fourth largest metropolitan area in the Nordic countries, Helsinki is Finland's major political, educational, financial, cultural, and research center as well as one of Northern Europe's major cities.

Climate

Helsinki's climate is typical of its northerly situation. Its intermediate climate combines characteristics of both a maritime and a continental climate. The proximity of the Arctic Ocean and the North Atlantic creates cold weather, while the Gulf Stream brings in warmer air.

Getting to Helsinki

Helsinki Airport serves around two hundred international flights each day. The journey time between the airport and city centre is around 30 minutes.

Transportation

By car: Street address: Messuaukio 1, 00520 Helsinki, Finland Address of the Messukeskus Car Park for GPS devices: Ratapihantie 17 Address of the Conference Centre for GPS devices: Ratamestarinkatu 13 By train: Local trains I and P operate between Helsinki Airport and the city centre on the Ring Rail Line, which opened in July 2015. The journey time between the airport and the city centre (Central Railway Station) is approximately half an hour. A regional ticket costs EUR 5,50 and can be purchased from Helsinki Region Transport (HSL) ticket machines and on board trains from a ticket sales carriage.

By bus: The Finnair City Bus operates between the airport and city centre (Elielinaukio) every 20 minutes and takes around 30 minutes. Click here to see the schedule. A single ticket costs EUR 6.20 when purchased online in advance or EUR 6.30 from the driver.

Bus 615 ("Lentoasema-Rautatientori") is operated by Helsinki Region Transport (HSL). A regional ticket costs EUR 5.50 and can be purchased from Helsinki Region Transport (HSL) ticket machines or from the driver with cash. At night you can also take the 415N night bus.

Taxi: Taxi stands are located outside the arrival terminals at Helsinki Airport. It takes around 15-20 minutes to the city centre and will cost around EUR 45.00.

Public Transport between the City Centre and Messukeskus

Messukeskus is located close to the centre of Helsinki, with excellent transport connections. EAACI will be using the Southern Entrance at Messuaukio 1 and the Northern Entrance on the same side as the car park.

I and P trains run from the airport to the nearby Pasila railway station. The journey time is 30 minutes. The trains leave every 10 minutes in the daytime. By taxi, you can reach Messukeskus in 15–20 minutes. Trams from the centre of Helsinki: 7A, 7B and 9

Buses: 506 and 69 to Messukeskus, and buss 551 from Espoo to Pasila railway station Trains: all local and long-distance trains stop at Pasila railway station, just a 300-metre walk from Messukeskus

Visa

Participants are advised to make their own arrangements with respect to entering Finland.


