Paul Hasler is professor of rheumatology and president of the research council at the Kantonsspital in Aarau (Switzerland). He is board certified in rheumatology (1994) and continued his study and extended his work experience on national and international level to 1994 when he was promoted to professor of rheumatology. He is responsible for several other functions; member of the University of Basel Medical Faculty, delegate to Faculty Assembly, member of the Biobank Committee of the Swiss Clinical Quality Management in Rheumatoid Arthritis (SCQM) Foundation, Editor, Seminars in Immunopathology - Springer, Grant review, Peer review for journals, Founding and past member of the board - SCQM Foundation. He has many publications in international peer-reviewed journals and is a member of various national and international professional societies (Swiss Medical Association, Medical Association of the Canton of Aargau, Swiss Internal Medicine Society, Swiss Rheumatology Society, Swiss Allergy and Immunology Society, American College of Rheumatology, European League against Rheumatism (EULAR)).
