





-I feel most comfortable in environments that emphasize equality and informality


-I feel most comfortable in environments that emphasize clarity and respect for positions

Choose a position

-I assume that people in certain positions know better than me, and that I should trust their judgement

-I assume that everyone makes mistakes, and that I should critically assess their judgments no matter who they are











Transition stress (culture shock)



- Can occur at various points of the process (not necessarily u-curved)
- Is combined with stages of excitement and optimism
 Can lead to uncertainty, identity/ belonging issues, hypochondria, depression/ anxiety, psychosomatic issues, and alcohol abuse
 Often creates low-acceptance or even hostility towards the rules, behaviors and
- habits of the host society.

Transition stress: case

- Woman around 50
- Has virtually only negative associations and experiences with Dutch people
- Has been married to a Dutch man for 22 years
 Speaks Dutch fluently but lives in the Netherlands for the first time
- Children are hitting puberty
 Has not worked since 1998 yet would like to re-start her career
- Moved to the Netherlands involuntarily on short notice




