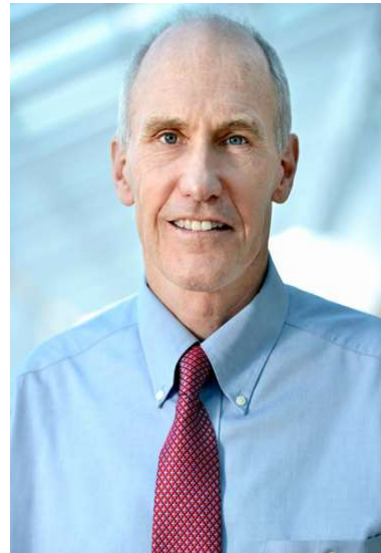

Improving Outcomes in AAV - What are the Unmet Needs?

This session will focus on the unmet needs in ANCA-associated vasculitis (AAV) from two perspectives.
