# INTRODUCTION

The first ever European congress in Paediatric physiotherapy will take place in Utrecht, The Netherlands in November 2019.

The congress is an initiative of the paediatric physiotherapy lecturers and researchers of the HU University of Applied Sciences, Utrecht. Those involved work at the Research Centre for Healthy and Sustainable Living, Research Group Lifestyle and Health, and/or the Institute of Human Movement Studies. Colleagues from the Dutch Society of Paediatric Physiotherapy, Center of Excellence for Rehabilitation Medicine/De Hoogstraat Rehabilitation and Wilhelmina Children's Hospital both from the University Medical Center Utrecht, Radboud University Medical Center, and Amsterdam University Medical Center are partners in the organization of the congress.

The Congress Programme Committee is developing a two-day programme containing novel research, innovations and best practices in paediatric physiotherapy. The collaboration between research, clinical practice and education provides the common thread in the program. Three themes are highlighted: (1) Early development, (2) Physical fitness and physical activity in children with physical disabilities, and (3) The impact of context and environment, working with children.

Paediatric physiotherapy is a recognized physiotherapy specialism which is established in The Netherlands with a long track record regarding education and which has its own research domain. Within Europe the variation in education and organization in the paediatric section is extensive. Therefore, we would like to get in contact to (European) physiotherapists who work with children, and/or are active in the field of research and education. The goal is to get to know eachother, to share knowledge and to explore possibilities for collaboration.

# INTRODUCTION

To connect and share, all participants are invited to bring their own best practices and posters. An abstract submission will be needed to organize the oral and posterpresentations.

The first day of the congress is state of the art, covering the three main themes with key-lectures, abstract sessions, and workshops. The second day focuses on future developments and collaboration.

Prior to the congress, on Thursday the 21st, two one-day courses are offered.

We are looking forward to wellcoming everyone to Utrecht in November.
