The Early Days: 2013


- Steep learning curve

### Note taking

- Main points we highlighted Pre Lyric in hearing:
- Impact of their hearing loss
- Lifestyle- priority situations
- Do they have tinnitus, if so how bothersome is it?





#### **TINNITUS**

- Tinnitus is the perception of sounds originating within the head of the observer in the absence of external auditory stimulation (McFadden, 1982).
- The prevalence of tinnitus is put at 10-15% of the population.
- 90% of those with tinnitus have hearing loss (HL). Hearing aid is the first line of management of tinnitus (sereda, M. et al 2018)
- Online: Tinnitus is searched 1.5 times more often that HL.

Had aid previously but tinnitus became more bothersome





### First Lyric tinnitus patient, 2014 John, Age: 58


Fitted Lyric-liked sound

1 week later-can't believe improvement, tinnitus much better

Rating of Tinnitus:

No Lyric-tinnitus =8-9

Lyric: Mostly 3, sometimes down to 1, 'hardly there'.





# Gavin, Age 42


Tried Mute Button, neuromodulation device

Tried other hearing devices

Lyric-minimal occlusion

Hearing well in company

Tinnitus significantly improved





- 57 year old Professor of Neurology, referred in 2016
- Unilateral SNHL, recruitment & Tinnitus
- Hx-Tinnitus started 1996 with vertigo.
- 2013: left hearing reduced 80%, recovering slightly but tinnitus increased. Seen by immunologist & ENT
- Tinnitus changes when stressed and suffers constant migraines.




#### **Patient Priorities**

- 1. Tinnitus Management
- 2. Localization: a keen cyclist
- 3. Hearing

#### What I recommended as options

- 1. Lyric, I was seeing good results for tinnitus
- 2. Left hearing aid with masker
- 3. CROS device






#### **On Fitting day**

Immediate improvement in her tinnitus

#### **Needed to confirm**

- 1. comfortable
- 2. If improves tinnitus
- 3. Improve hearing






#### One week later

According to patient:


- Tinnitus still lower, not as intrusive
- Hearing improved by 30-40%
- Main improvement was in the tinnitus





#### Two weeks later


- Not physically aware of Lyric in the ear
- Tinnitus improved further, no more tonal tinnitus
- Headaches greatly improved
- Some distortion with soprano, no other problems with tolerance of loud sounds





#### Two months later (change of device)


- No more headaches and no neck pain
- Tinnitus continues to be much better she attributes directly to Lyric
- She reported there is evidence of headaches and neck pain being secondary to tinnitus.





#### 6 months later

Headaches still no longer noticeable



#### One year later

- Period of significant stress, fullness in ear, dizziness, some tinnitus but still greatly reduced with Lyric.
- Didn't want audiogram- 'don't want to know'.....medics!



# Why is Lyric so Effective for Tinnitus?

- 24/7 auditory stimulation
- IN Ear & Hearing, 2017, up to 90% of those with tinnitus might benefit from amplification due to:
- 1. Reduce tinnitus intrusiveness
- 2. Aiding habituation
- 3. Distracting attention from tinnitus
- 4. Triggering neuroplastic changes in brain.



Came looking for tinnitus solution


Previously had CIC from another clinic

RIGHT: 100@%@50dBHL

LEFT: 83%@ 85dBHL (right masked)

Speech In Noise:

**RIGHT:1dB SNR Normal** 

LEFT: 6dB SNR Mild

Tinnitus Pitch Match: matched at 3kHz & 8kHz.



### Prior to Lyric

• Tinnitus Functional Index

Overall Score: 76.

Tinnitus is a very big problem/ severe enough to qualify for more

aggressive intervention (>50)

# Brian, age 25 TFI Comparison

Clinically significant reduction: 13points is considered meaningful reduction in outcomes scores (Hall, 2014)



Interestingly- he turns off Lyric at night, finds the loud tinnitus strangely soothing!. i.e. don't presume everyone is the same.

In my experience, you learn more listening to your patients, it's a journey together.



### Larry, Age 57



- Main complaint tinnitus, completely interfering with sleep.
- Has been on Mute Button trial which improved volume of tinnitus in left, no improvement in right
- Initially only wanted help for right tinnitus, could manage left.

Speech discrimination: Right: 90% @60dBHL

Left: 90% @60dBHL

**Tinnitus Match:** 


Right: 25dB @2kHz pure tone



### Barry, Age 58

- Hx- Bang to head playing rugby 20 years ago,
  conductive loss, grommet inserted, no improvement,
  then grommet removed after which tinnitus started.
- Constant high pitch tinnitus 4kHz.
- Difficulty hearing in noise.





# Barry, Age 58

Fitted March 2015, noticed immediate improvement in tinnitus.

5 days later: delighted- cannot hear tinnitus.



# Lyric and Tinnitus

- 79 active subscriptions
  - 40 with no tinnitus
  - 39 with tinnitus
    - 12 patients bilaterally
    - 15 patients unilaterally





# Lyric and Tinnitus

Troublesome Tinnitus	Results
No change in tinnitus	1 (3%)
Slight improvement in tinnitus	22 (56%)
Significant improvement in tinnitus	11 (28%)
Tinnitus no longer noticeable	5 (13%)
	39 (100%)
